- Remembering – working through the past, giving survivors of the Holocaust a voice
- Reconciliation – healing and restoration between descendants of the victims and perpetrators
- Taking a stand – for Israel and against modern anti-Semitism

MARCH OF LIFE – VALUES:

- We declare that according to Gen 12:3 we as a nation are called to be a blessing for Israel!
- We declare that we honor the memory of the Holocaust and the voices of the survivors and that we stand together with them in remembering the horrors of the Holocaust.
- We declare that at a time of newly rising anti-Semitism we will not allow the past's silent indifference to spread yet again.
- In the March of Life we stand together with those who have suffered or who still suffer from the consequences of the Holocaust.
- We give them a public voice to break the "Veil of Silence" over our cities together with them.
- The March of Life expresses the spirit of reconciliation in the close cooperation with Jewish communities and different Christian churches, congregations and denominations.
- The March of Life is not the podium for political demands, nor is it a protest or a platform for evangelism; but it is a memorial and prayer movement.
