The exhibition in Jerusalem highlights the church's role in the roots of antisemitism and shares the message of the global March of Life Movement, which unites confronting family history with a strong voice for Israel.

OUR VISION

This pop-up exhibition offers a first glimpse of the **permanent exhibition planned in Jerusalem**. It aims to inspire international visitors to Israel to break the Veil of Silence over antisemitism—especially within their own countries and churches.

We believe **transformation** is possible: former enemies can become friends who speak out against antisemitism and stand in true solidarity with Israel.

The exhibition builds bridges between Christian and Jewish visitors by exposing the deep-rooted history of **antisemitism**, shaped by 2,000 years of Christian anti-Judaism. Inspired by the legacy of Tübingen—the birthplace of the global **March of Life movement**—it encourages visitors to confront their family history and align with God’s heart for Israel and the Jewish people.

More than a place of historical learning, this exhibition seeks to be a space of **hope and encouragement** for the Jewish people—a place for honest dialogue, healing, and authentic friendship.
